WHO?

This group is open to adult individuals who use hearing aids and their communication partners, as well as individuals who do not currently use devices but would like to address their hearing difficulties.





WHAT?

- Sessions are in-person for around 1.25 hours
- Session are led by an audiologist and graduate MS-SLP students
- Class size is limited to 10 individuals.
- Session content is member driven and will vary each week but will include topics such as:
 - o How does hearing work?
 - Why are conversations in noise so difficult?
 - Why don't people talk clearly and what can I do about it?
 - How do I use my technology effectively?
- Group participation is no cost. Donations are welcome.
